

Understanding Plumber/Gas Fitter Licensing Types and Requirements

- Any person performing plumbing and/or natural gas fitting MUST hold a certification with the Board.
- An Apprentice Plumber/Gas Fitter must be supervised on the job site at all times by a Journeyman or Master Plumber and/or Gas Fitter.
- A Journeyman Plumber and/or Gas Fitter must work for a company who has a properly certified Master Plumber and/or Gas Fitter, but may work on job sites alone or supervise apprentices.
- A Master Plumber and/or Gas Fitter may work on their own or supervise apprentices on the job site.
- All Plumbing and/or Gas Fitting companies must be properly registered with the Board.
- Someone who holds solely a Plumbing card can not do gas fitting. Someone who holds solely a Gas Fitting card can not do plumbing.
